# **OPPORTUNITIES**



The <u>Opportunities</u> page on the Reframe website will show relevant and available opportunities for RLOs to network and get support for their work depending on the thematic areas they focus on.

#### Here are some of the latest opportunities:

- <u>Fondation Mireux</u> is giving grants to support organizations working in the education, HIV/AIDs thematic areas. Please go to their website and check out their eliqibility criteria before applying.
- <u>Needs List</u> is a platform that allows CBOs/RLOs/NGOs to fundraise for basic needs and non-food items that vulnerable community members may need in a crisis situation. Please <u>CLICK HERE</u> to request access and register your organization on the platform especially if you work in emergency settings.
- <u>Kuja Link</u> KujaLink facilitates direct donor access to local and national civil society organizations (CSOs) in countries which receive development assistance and humanitarian aid. The platform enhances the visibility of and helps establish connections between funders and CSOs leading to an increase in direct giving. Please <u>CLICK HERE</u> to find out more.
- <u>DWF Foundation</u> -is giving grants to support organizations working in the education, livelihoods, Homelessness, Health and Well-being & Environmental Sustainability thematic areas. Please <u>CLICK HERE</u> to apply or go to their website and check out their eligibility criteria before applying.
- The <u>WaterLoo Foundation</u> is giving out grants to organizations supporting environmental programmes. Please <u>CLICK HERE</u> to check out their eligibility criteria and their application process.

<u>UNLEASH</u>- is a week-long (ish) bootcamp focused on developing solutions to the UN Sustainable Development Goals. Accepted participants will travel to Rwanda where they will be placed on a team, given training in the basics of human-centered program and project design, and asked to develop a solution to a specific social impact challenge.
